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**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO M.A. in BENGALI, ENGLISH, HISTORY,**  
**PHILOSOPHY, POLITICAL SCIENCE , SANSKRIT, M.Sc /M.A IN MATHEMATICS & M.Sc IN COMPUTER SCIENCE**

Eligibility:

- A minimum 2nd class Hons. (Regular or Special) graduate in the relevant subject having pursued the course in the 10+2+3 pattern from any recognized University, or
- An unsuccessful Hons. Graduate of the above pattern (i) who after having pursued the Hons. course at both the Part-I, Part-II and Part-III stages obtained Pass Degree certificate of 3 year course securing at least 35% marks in aggregate (in concerned Hons.subject), or
- A minimum 2nd class Hons. (Regular or Special) graduate in the relevant subject having pursued the course of the old 11+3 pattern, or
- A pass graduate in the 10+2+3 pattern having offered the relevant subject as a combination / elective one (of not less than 300 marks at the degree stage) securing at least 30% marks in it, or
- B.Sc, / B.Com. / B.A. Pass Graduates who subsequently passed Special B.A. (of not less than 300 marks in the relevant subject) securing at least 30% marks in it, or
- A pass graduate in the 10+2+2 / 10+1+3 / 11+3 pattern from any recognized institute who subsequently passed 1 year Bridge Course in the

relevant subject (of not less than 300 marks at the degree level) and thus became equivalent to a pass graduate of 10+2+3 pattern securing at least 40% marks in it, or

- An M.A. in a subject willing to do M.A. in any other subject offered through Distance Mode irrespective of whether or not that subject was offered by him / her at the degree stage, provided that no M.A. in any professional subject like Music, Drama, Film Studies, Physical Education (M.P.Ed.), General Education (M.Ed.) etc. is entitled to this special provision. Provided further that no M.A. in “Islamic History and Culture” or “Ancient History and Culture” from any University is entitled to do M.A. again in History from this University.

Duration: 2 Years

Pattern: Yearly (Term-end Examination)

**Name of the Course: M.A. in MATHEMATICS**

Eligibility:

- A minimum 2nd Class Hons. (Regular or Special) graduate in Mathematics having pursued the course in the 10+2+3 pattern from any recognized University, or
- An unsuccessful Hons. Candidate of the above pattern (i) but who after having pursued the Hons. course at both the Part-I, Part-II and Part-III stages obtained Pass Degree certificate of 3 year course securing at least 35% marks in aggregate in Hons. subject, or
- A minimum 2nd class Hons. (Regular or special) graduate in Mathematics having pursued the course of the old 11+3 pattern, or
- B.A. graduate in the 10+2+3 pattern having offered Mathematics as combination / elective one (of not less than 300 marks at the degree stage) securing at least 30% marks in it, or
- B.A. graduate in the 10+2+2 / 10+1+3 / 11+3

pattern from any recognized institute, who subsequently passed 1 year bridge course in Mathematics securing at least 40% marks in it.

Duration: 2 Years

Pattern: Semester (4 Semesters)

Course Name: M.Com.

Eligibility:

- A minimum 2nd Class Hons. (Regular or Special) graduate in Commerce having pursued the course in the 10+2+3 pattern from any recognized University, or
- An unsuccessful Hons. Candidate of the above pattern (i) but who after having pursued the Hons. course at both the Part-I, Part-II and Part-III stages obtained Pass Degree certificate of 3 year course securing at least 35% marks in aggregate in Hons. subject, or

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- A minimum 2nd class Hons. (Regular or special) graduate in Commerce of the old 11+3 pattern, or
- A pass commerce graduate in the pattern securing a minimum of 30% marks in aggregate, or
- A pass commerce graduate in the 10+2+2 / 10+1+3 / 11+3 pattern from any recognized institute, who subsequently passed 1 year bridge course in commerce and thus became equivalent to a pass graduate of 10+2+3 pattern securing at least 40% marks in it.

Duration: 2 Years

Pattern: Yearly (Term-end Examination)

**Name of the Course: M.Sc. in COMPUTER SCIENCE**

Eligibility:

- B.Sc. (Hons.) in Computer Science; or
- Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA); or
- B.E. or equivalent; or
- B.Sc. (Hons.) in Mathematics / Statistics / Electronics / Physics / Chemistry with Computer Science as one of the combination subject.

Duration: 2 Years

Pattern: Semester (4 Semesters)

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO MBA PROGRAMME:**

- a. A Graduate of 10+2+3 pattern from any recognised University ;  
&  
b. Candidate should have qualified MAT /CMAT / CAT / XAT/Other recognised Management Aptitude Test Score.

In case any candidate does not have any of the above mentioned scores, he/she has to appear and secure valid score in the Entrance Test to be conducted by the University of Burdwan. (Candidates are required to produce online payment receipt / University copy of bank challan and Valid ID proof at the time of Entrance test).


Qualified candidates in the written test and qualified MAT /CMAT / CAT / XAT/Other recognised Management Aptitude Test Score will have to appear for Group Discussion (GD) & Personal Interview (PI) with valid ID proof. Candidates will be finally selected on the basis of the composite score obtained in GD & PI.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO B.Ed(ODL) PROGRAMME**

- The following categories are eligible to be students of B.Ed. (ODL) :
  - (i) Trained In-Service teachers in elementary education.
  - (ii) Candidates who have completed an NCTE recognised Teacher Education Programme through face-to-face mode.
  - (iii) The reservation and relaxation in marks for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Govt./State Govt., whichever is applicable.
- Selection of 1st Method Subject: Candidates from General (pass) course will normally choose one subject from their Graduation as 1st Method subject while candidates from Hons. Course will normally choose their Hons. Subject as 1st Method Subject.
- P.G. Level: Candidates who have P.G. in a particular subject can also apply and choose it as 1st Method subject.



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
