"*The School for Scandal* is a comedy of manners, satirizing the social values, virtues, and vices of its time." Do you agree with this view? Justify your answer.

- d. Give a critical estimate of Jimmy Porter as an 'angry young man' in Osborne's *Look Back in Anger*.
- e. Comment on the use of non-verbal elements in Waiting for Godot.
- f. Discuss Shaw's portrayal of Joan in Saint Joan.

#### Or

Discuss martyrdom as the central theme of the play Murder in the Cathedral.

- 2. Answer *any two* of the following:
  - a. Comment on the following: "Why, this is hell, nor am I out of it."
  - b. Explain: 'Good morning to the day; and next, my gold'.
  - c. Briefly comment on the 'echo' scene in The Duchess of Malfi.
  - d. What do bears and squirrels symbolize in Look Back in Anger?
  - e. Bring out the significance of Estragon's foetal posture in Waiting for Godot.
