Programme Project Report (PPR) for M.A. in Political Science

The University of Burdwan, a public university located in Purba Bardhaman, West Bengal, was established by the West Bengal Government as a teaching and affiliating university on 15th June, 1960. Since then, this university has flourished as a premiere institute of advanced learning and research. It was the first of its kind in West Bengal to cater education through distance/correspondence mode and eventually, it evolved as an independent centre for learning. Situated in Golapbag, Burdwan, at present, this centre has a beautiful building of its own that houses all the administrative and academic departments. It also holds counseling sessions for the different courses it runs.

In a meeting of the Advisory Committee of the Vice-Chancellors of all state aided universities of West Bengal held on 27.10.1993, it was decided that the University of Burdwan would introduce Correspondence Courses (Vide letter no. 96(2)-Edn (U)/10(C)-14/92, dated: 22.02.1994). In the 21st meeting of the Executive Council (1993-1994) of The University of Burdwan (held on 30th may 1994 vide Item no. 8), it was resolved that the University of Burdwan in accordance with its Act, Statutes, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations and with the approval of the State Govt. P.G Courses through Distance mode leading to M.A/M.Com Degrees with six programmes, viz., Bengali, English, History, Political Science, Philosophy and Commerce would be offered.

1. Programme's Mission and Objectives:

- To provide an effective alternative path to wider opportunities in education and especially in higher education: There are different categories of potential learners. There are some who never been able to enter into any institution of higher learning. There are some who just need additional knowledge in a particular discipline. There are still others who are in need of refresher courses to cope with the latest development in their perfection. For all of those there is need for distance learning or correspondence education.
 - To provide an efficient and less expensive education: Provision of universal schooling is beyond the means of our country. Increasing population and limited resources is the predicament of our educational planners. It is difficult to divert huge sums of money in a developing economy to match the required level of expansion for traditional schooling. Distance education is the only practical alternative.

- To provide education facilities to all qualified and willing persons: The objective of correspondence courses is to provide education facilities to all qualified and willing persons who are unable to join regular university and other courses due tovarious reasons. For them, there is an incessant search for an alternative system and that system is distanceeducation.
- To provide opportunities of academic pursuits to educated citizens willing to improve their standard of knowledge: There are many learners, both young and adults, who cannot afford to join the face-to-face system of education due to personal and professional responsibilities. For such type of persons, some provisions have to be made through distance education. Hence, the objective is to provide opportunities to improve the standard of knowledge and learning through continuing education while in employment.
- To provide education facilities to those individuals who look upon education as a life-long activity: Distance education facilities are needed for those individuals who look upon education as a life-long activity or to acquire knowledge in a new area. Because life-long education is emphasized for all stages of life. In this context, the report of the National Policy on Education, 1986 is worth- mentioninghere.

The NPE-1986 says, "Life-long education is a cherished goal of the educational process. This presupposes universal literacy. Opportunities will be provided to the youth, housewives, agricultural and industrial workers and professionals to continue the education of their choice, at the pace suited to them. The future thrust will be in the direction of open and distance learning."

The distance learning system must be well-supported with instructional materials, and suitable radio and television programmes in different areas of study. This correspondence education or distance learning is becoming popular and being accepted as an alternative and economical approach to our formal educationsystem.

- To provide a system of student-centric learning atmosphere which will neither be entirely separated from nor wholly independent of the formal, full-time campus system of education as traditionally followed in university department ofstudies.
- The Post Graduate Programme in Political Science at the Centre for Distance and Online Education (previously known as Directorate of Distance Education), The University of Burdwan is in keeping with spirit of Political Science curricula with regular mode of University. The objectives are in keeping with this mission that is to instill interest of the learners and take them through the ages of literary history via their landmark authors and their texts. 2. Relevance of the Programme with HEI's Mission & Goals:

Student loans, rent, and other related expenses have proven to be a heavy burden for many individuals and their families in the long run. However, in the last few years, there has been a significant drop in tuition fees, primarily in secondary schools and colleges, due to the introduction of the distance education option. Namely, not only did the tuition fees drop because the school/educational institution's facilities and inventory were no longer used, but the expenses related to food, accommodation and all the other needs students have on a daily basis dropped as well. So, if you don't have enough money for a quality education, you should consider distance education.
 - One of the best things about distance learning is the fact that students from all over the world can get any degree they want, which had previously been impossible due to geographical constraints. Things have changed, however, thanks to the Internet and technologies that significantly simplified the application and enrollment process, helping applicants to skip the state administrative protocol. Also the same examination system (same question papers, same date of end-term Semester examinations, same Post Graduate Board of Studies (PGBS)) is in force in the distance mode of Political Science discipline since2019-2021.

- **DUE TO COVID19 SITUATION** (Since the end of March, 2020) All the PCPs of M.A. in Political Science have been completed through online mode (Google Meet). All the examinations of M.A. in Political Science have been completed through online (Email submission) and all the internal assessments of M.A. in Political Science via GoogleForm and Email.
- Student Support Service System: Students are facilitated to contact the faculty members and the office by phone or email or in person. The CDOE maintains a well- equipped library and a computer centre where the students can access various resources. Subject-wise helpdesk, Enquiry Centre, Counseling rooms, wellequipped classrooms, conference hall, whatsapp groups etc. are there to help the students. Other facilities like purified drinking water, restroom, canteen, auditorium, free wifi etc. are also available.

6. Procedure for admissions, curriculum transaction and evaluation:

Admission Procedure: Through Admission Notification published in leading newspapers and through CDOE's Website as well University Website. Whole Admission Procedure is going on through online.

Eligibility: Any Political Science Honours, General Graduates (10+2+3) with Political Science as combination, any Graduates (10+2+2) who subsequently passed One-year Bridge Course in Political Science.

Total Course fee: Rs. 10000/- (inclusive all 4 semesters).

Financial Assistant: Financial assistant is provided to some financially backward students for this programme.

Curriculum transaction: SLMs (Bengali version) in print/soft copies are provided as approved by the CDOE. PCP/Counseling schedules for the programme are prepared by the core faculty and assistant professor with the help of course coordinator. PCP/Counseling schedules circulated among the study centres as well as notified in the official website of the CDOE. PCP/Counseling is conducted in English and Bengali.

Medium of Examination: English and Bengali.

Evaluation: Semester System Examinations (written):

- > 20% of the total marks of each 50 marks paper are Internal Assessment (Short type questions).
- > 80% of the total marks of each 50 marks paper would be reserved for written examination to be held per semester.

A few notable features of the rules governing the examination of Semester System P.G Course under distance mode:

The examination of M.A. is divided into four semester examinations which hold as per schedule notified by Controller of Examinations from time to time after

completion of its relevantPCP.

A candidate shall get three consecutive chances including the original one to appear in a semester, within a total period of four years calculated from the year of admission to the course during which he/she has to complete the course. The chance not availed of by a candidate shall be deemed to have lapsed. The result of the 4th semester (Final) examination shall be kept withheld (RW) unless the candidate has cleared all the previous semesters.

Preparation of SLMs: In 1999 first 3 Day workshop was organized by our Directorate with the financial Assistance of DEC. In this workshop regular faculty members of our University as well as other Universities participated. Prof. V. S. Prasad, former Pro-Vice-Chancellor of IGNOU and Dr. Santosh Panda, Director, STRIDE acted as Resource persons in the said workshop. Then several subject-wise seminars and workshops were organized by the Directorate of Distance Education (DDE), The University of Burdwan(B.U.). Accordingly as per direction of university authority, a number of writers of SLMs of all the subjects/programmes were appointed and also Editorial Boards, Format Editors and General Editors of all the subjects/programmes were formed by the direction of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. The entire process was approved by the Advisory Committee of DDE, B.U. and Vice-Chancellor. After Publication of the SLMs, two sets of all study materials were sent to DEC for approval as per their direction. In February, 2013, an Expert Team from DEC visited our Directorate and the members thoroughly checked all study materials and they appreciated the whole process. In view of their recommendation, few months later, the letter of recognition of the programme as well as approval of SLMs was sent by DEB (Vide letter no. UGC/DEB/Recog/2013/1203-1207, dated: 21stAugust, 2015).

Updated notification for its learners: CDOE notifies its various policies for the programme delivery along with the details of methods and web-based tools adopted in the official website. All academic notifications are being carried out by the CDOE during the academic session through the official website (www.dde.buruniv.ac.in) and to the learners through SMS. Further, the CDOE notifies result and related information of examination evaluation through its official website and registered mobile number of the learners.
